### TERMS & CONDITIONS

Bedwellty House asks clients to be aware that all wedding bookings are conducted on the basis of our standard Terms and Conditions.

### 1. Confirmation

A provisional booking for the date of your choice will be held for a maximum of 14 days. After 14 days, Bedwellty House requires written confirmation and a non-refundable/ non-transferable booking fee of £250. The booking is confirmed on receipt of the deposit. Then a further £250 is required 12 months before your wedding. Wedding bookings made within a 12 month period of the wedding date will be required to pay £500 booking fee that is non-refundable/non-transferable. A charge of 3.0% will be applicable to all credit card transactions over £400.

### 2. Payments

Eight weeks prior to the date of your wedding a pro-forma invoice will be issued for the final total. Settlement of this is required 28 days prior to the wedding. Any additional costs must be settled prior to departure. All prices are inclusive of VAT at the current rate. VAT will always be charged at the same rate in force at the time of final payment. Priority payment plans are available on request. A charge of 3.0% will be applicable to all credit card transactions over £400.

### 3. Cancellations

Should you wish to cancel your booking; a charge will be made, calculated as a percentage of the total value, according to the scale highlighted below:

12 - 6 months before the wedding25	,,,
4 - 6 months before the wedding50	)%
1 - 3 months before the wedding	5%
Less than 1 month before the wedding100	)%

All cancellations should be confirmed in writing by the client. Cancellation will be in effect from the date of receipt of written confirmation. The cancellation fee must be paid 14 days of any cancellation (excluding weddings cancelled within 1 calendar month of the wedding date in which case payment is due in full immediately). Please note all bookings and dates are non transferable.

### 4. Confirmation of Number of Guests

Approximate numbers must be confirmed with Bedwellty House at the time of booking. It is this figure that will act as the minimum number of guests to be paid for in the event of a cancellation. Final numbers must be confirmed with Bedwellty House 28 days prior to the wedding along with final payment.

### 5. Food & Beverages

Evening buffets must be ordered for the total number of guests attending the evening function. Any wines or spirits brought to the House are subject to a corkage fee, you will need to confirm the costs with the wedding coordinator. Any guest found bringing wines, spirits or beer into the premises, for their consumption, will be charged accordingly and asked to leave the premises. No outside catering other than chocolate fountains are permitted at the House. We do not allow wedding cake to be served as dessert for the Wedding Breakfast, but it can be served on the evening buffet.

### 6. Etiquette and Conduct

For the comfort and safety of all our guests and employees there is a compulsory security charge of £180 for door supervisors for all evening receptions. This will be added to the final bill. It is important that all members of your party maintain acceptable levels of behaviour and noise on the House premises. In the unlikely event that you are requested to intervene by the House management, you must take the necessary steps to ensure that the members of your party adhere to this policy. In the event of your failure to comply with this request, the House management may stop the wedding reception without being liable for refund or compensation. Children attending the wedding must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult.

### 7. Price Guarantee

All prices are current and inclusive of VAT, unless otherwise stated. Whilst every effort will be made to maintain current prices, they may be subject to alteration at management discretion, without prior notice. Where prices have yet to be set in respect of the date of your wedding, any bookings confirmed will be subject to the knowledge that annual increases may apply.

### 8. Damage

The client is responsible to Bedwellty House for any damage caused to fixtures, fittings, property and/or buildings of the House by the client or their guests or agents. Any such damage will be charged for in full.

### 9. Wedding Brochure Information

All information in this brochure were correct at the time of printing and are subject to change without prior notice. Bedwellty House cannot accept responsibility for any errors or omissions.

All arrangements featured in this brochure are subject to availability.

### 10. Theft

Bedwellty House is not liable for any loss or damages to guest's belongings and personal possessions within the House's premises howsoever such loss or damage may have been caused. Guests are responsible for the protection of their own property and should keep their belongings with them and under their control at all times.

### 11. Licensing Hours

Function bar closing times are as follows:

# Legal Requirements for Getting Married

Before you can marry in England or Wales, each person to the marriage has to arrange to begin the Legal process.

### CIVIL CEREMONY

If you are having a civil ceremony at Bedwellty House, it will be necessary for you to give Notice of Marriage to the Superintendent Registrar. You can give Notice of Marriage up to one year before the date of your Marriage. This will then begin the process that will eventually allow a Registrar or authorised person to register the marriage – Please telephone the Superintendent Registrar on 01495 353374 to discuss this process in more detail.

### RELIGIOUS CEREMONY

If the marriage is to be a religious ceremony in a Church of England or Church in Wales, prior to the ceremony the vicar will arrange for the banns to be read. However, if the ceremony is in a building of any other religious denomination, you must give legal notice to the Superintendent Registrar.

### GIVING NOTICE

Once you have chosen the date and venue for your wedding, you must arrange to give Notice of Marriage to the Superintendent Registrar of the District in which you live. You must be resident in the district for at least seven days immediately prior to giving your Notice – (if you live in different districts' each of you must give notice in your own district) – If you live in Blaenau Gwent - the Register office is at:

It will be necessary for you to make an appointment with the Superintendent Registrar to give Notice of your Marriage.

### DOCUMENTATION THAT YOU WILL NEED TO BRING WITH YOU

When you make an appointment to give Notice of Marriage, the Registrar will explain in detail the required documents you will need to bring with you – for example Passport, Birth Certificate, Decree Absolute and proof of address. There is a fee to be paid – please visit the Register Office website for up to date fees.

The purpose of giving Notice of Marriage is for the Superintendent Registrar to ensure you are lawfully free to marry and to complete the legal documentation for your Marriage.
